Introduction

Please carefully read the following terms and conditions before using the i2xl Software. If there are any questions, please contact Norledge Software Inc. at info@norledge.ca.

1. Definitions

Licensor means Norledge Software Inc. registered in the province of Ontario, Canada.

Licensee means the Corporate Entity that has been granted the right to install and use the i2xl application Software.

You means the reader and the Corporate Entity having downloaded the i2xl application Software.

Software means the i2xl application Software and associated documentation created and owned by Norledge Software Inc.

Computer system means the computer for which the Software is licensed and intended for use. It can only be installed on an IBM Midrange computer otherwise identified as an AS/400 or iSeries computer.

2. Permitted Use

The Licensee and its employees are permitted unlimited, non-exclusive use of the Software during the time period granted by the Licensor, providing the use falls within the permitted use set out below and for no other purpose.

3. Restrictions on Use

3.1 Use of the Software is restricted to the Computer (identified by model number and serial number), designated on the License Key request.

3.2 You may not, nor permit others to copy, modify or transfer the Software and/or associated documentation or copy of such, except as expressly provided for in this License Agreement.

3.3 You may not, nor permit others to create derivative works based upon the Software, translate, disassemble, decompile, reverse engineer or modify the Software, delete, vary or obscure any copyright notices contained in or associated with the Software.

3.4 You may not sub-license the Software.

4. Software Maintenance

4.1 Software upgrades and modifications will be provided free of charge during the term of the Licensing agreement. Where necessary, conversion programs will be provided in order to convert existing i2xl definitions and dependent database data.

4.2 Where Software upgrades or modifications are provided, you will be responsible for taking backup copies of the existing installed Software and database data and for testing the Software following installation of the upgrades or modifications.

4.3 Terms, conditions and clauses of this agreement will apply to the Software upgrades, modifications and conversion programs and to the Software following the incorporation of the upgrades and modifications.

5. Software Support

5.1 Problems or issues related to the Software or associated documentation should be emailed to support@norledge.ca. The Licensor will respond to all requests within a reasonable time frame.

5.2 Where an issue is related to a particular report, an excerpt of the report or a screen shot of the definition maintenance screen should be attached to the request. Any such attachment will be treated with confidentiality and will immediately be deleted following analysis and resolution.

5. Evaluation and Licensing

When first installed, the Software is provided with an evaluation license key which allows the Software to operate for a period of 30 days. At the discretion of the Licensor, the evaluation period may be extended. At the end of the evaluation period, in order to continue to use the Software you must obtain, subject to payment, a permanent license key from the Licensor.

6. Ownership

The Licensor retains ownership of the Software and associated documentation and all copies of the Software and associated documentation at all times, which are copyright works protected under applicable laws.

7. Disclaimer of Warranty
